Reporting a Violation of the Standards of Academic Honesty

The student selects one of two possible appeal options:

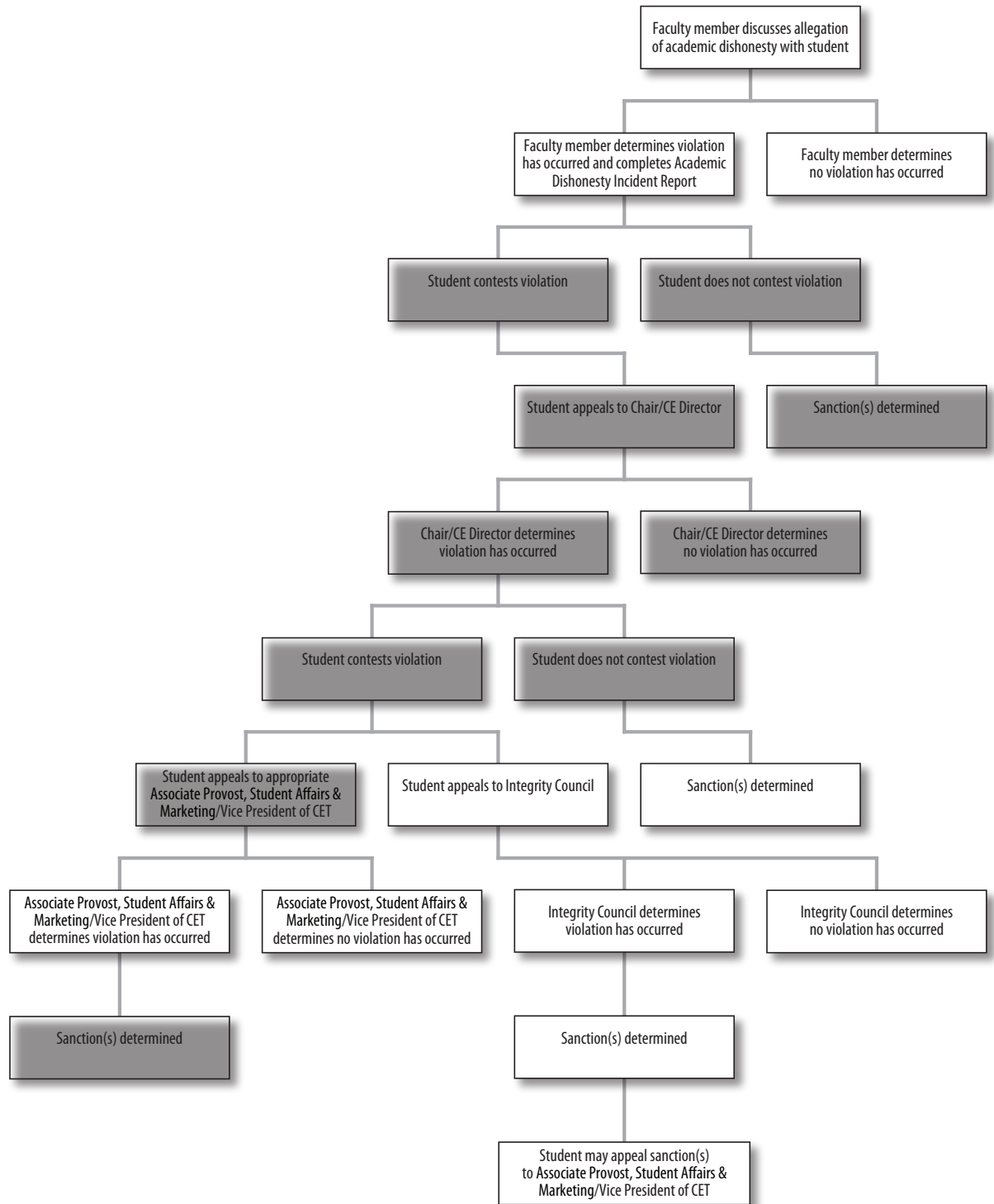
- The student may elect to have the Associate Provost, Student Affairs & Marketing or Vice President of Continuing Education and Training render a decision relative to whether a violation of the Standards of Academic Honesty has occurred. However, if it is the third violation, the student will be referred to the Integrity Council.
- The student may elect to have the Integrity Council review the case. The Integrity Council will hold a hearing and then render a decision relative to whether the student violated the Standards of Academic Honesty. The student must submit in writing a request for a hearing to the Integrity Council Chairperson within five working days of the decision of the Division Chair/Director.

Note: The Provost will serve as the final appeal when a student is charged with committing academic dishonesty by either the Associate Provost of Student Affairs & Marketing or Vice President of Continuing Education.
