Financing Your RN-to-BSN as a Dual-Admission Partnership Student

Your nursing education is an important investment. Financial aid and scholarships can help **make your goals a reality.**

The University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) offers opportunities to help you afford your undergraduate education.

▶ **While you are still enrolled in your Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program, as a Dual-Admission Partnership student:**

Receive scholarship funding that covers in-state tuition and fees for all UMSON RN-to-BSN courses in which you enroll while you are still enrolled in your ADN program at your community college. This special funding is available dependent upon continued philanthropic support. No separate application is needed to receive this funding.

▶ **Once you graduate with your ADN:**

You have several options, including:

- **Apply for the Conway Scholarship.** This scholarship covers in-state tuition, fees, and books for the duration of your academic program and does not require demonstration of financial need. It also provides you with a mentor. Learn more at nursing.umaryland.edu/conway.

Note that while you do not need to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for the Conway Scholarship, you will be required to submit the FAFSA to receive the scholarship funds once the scholarship has been awarded.

- **Apply for other forms of financial aid** (including federal, state, and University) by completing the FAFSA. The FAFSA deadline for Maryland residents (state awards and scholarships) is Feb. 28. For all other awards, the deadline is March 1. UMSON's federal code is 002104.
- **Utilize tuition reimbursement** funding from your employer.
